

**NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS  
OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION**  
R.C. 3501.11(G), 5705.19, 5705.25

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Fairfield of Fairfield, Ohio passed on the 31st day of January, 2022, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the Primary Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 3rd day of May, 2022, the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of City of Fairfield for the providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings, and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm communications, for the payment of fire-fighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.34 of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or fire-fighting company or for the payment of other related costs. Tax being a replacement of seven and fifteen hundredths (7.15) mills and an increase of two and one tenth (2.1) mills to constitute a tax of nine and twenty- five hundredths (9.25) mills at a rate not exceeding nine and twenty- five hundredths (9.25) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ninety-two and five tenth cents (\$0.925) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
